**WAIVER OF CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS, AGREEMENT TO STIPULATE, AND JUDICIAL CONFESSION**

In open court and prior to entering my plea, I waive the right of trial by jury. I also waive the appearance, confrontation, and cross-examination of witnesses, and my right against self-incrimination. The charges against me allege that in Harris County, Texas, JACKSON, CHRISTOPHER MALCOLM, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about MAY 12, 2024, did then and there unlawfully, The duly organized Grand Jury of Harris County, Texas, presents in the District Court of Harris County, Texas, that in Harris County, Texas, CHRISTOPHER MALCOLM JACKSON, hereafter styled the Defendant, heretofore on or about May 12, 2024, did then and there unlawfully, appropriate by acquiring and exercising control over property, namely, a watch, owned by Michael Pohl, hereinafter called the Complainant, of the value of at least thirty thousand dollars and less than one hundred fifty thousand dollars, with the intent to deprive the Complainant of the property.

Before the commission of the offense alleged above, (hereafter styled the primary offense), on April 13, 1988, in Cause Number CR87-282E, in the Superior CC 5 of Marion County, Indiana, the Defendant was convicted of the felony offense of Burglary.

Before the commission of the primary offense, and after the conviction in Cause Number CR87-282E was final, the Defendant committed the felony offense of Burglary and was finally convicted of that offense on April 12, 1990, in Cause Number 90CR8460, in the Cook County Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois.

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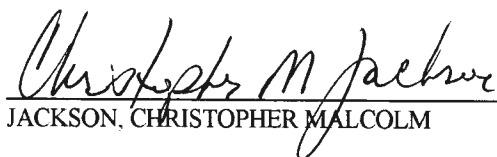
I understand the above allegations and I confess that they are true and that the acts alleged above were committed on MAY 12, 2024.

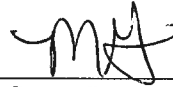

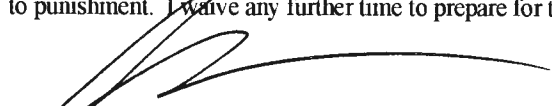

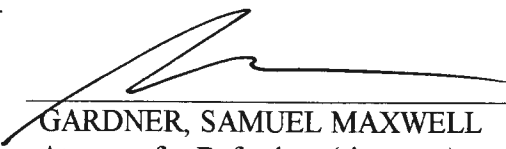

**PERMISSION TO APPEAL:** If the punishment assessed by the court does not exceed the punishment recommended by the prosecutor and agreed to by you and your attorney, the court must give its permission to you before you may prosecute an appeal on any matter in this case except for those matters raised by you by written motion filed prior to trial.

**CITIZENSHIP:** If you are not a citizen of the United State of America, a plea of guilty or not contendere for the offense with which you are charged in this case may result In your deportation, your exclusion from admission to this country, or your denial of naturalization under federal law; **My attorney has advised me that this plea will result in the following immigration consequences for me:**

CMJ **DEFERRED ADJUDICATION:** I understand that if the court defers entering a finding of guilt and places me on deferred adjudication community supervision:

- Upon a violation of a condition of community supervision, I may be arrested and detained.
- I will be entitled to a hearing limited to the determination by the Court of whether to proceed with an adjudication of guilt on the original charge. If the Court determines that I violated a condition of probation, the Court may assess my punishment within the full range of punishment for this offense.
- After an adjudication, all proceedings, including the assessment of punishment, pronouncement of sentence, and granting of community supervision, continue as if the adjudication of guilt had not been deferred.
- If I successfully complete this deferred adjudication, I may be eligible to petition the Court for non-disclosure of the criminal history record information related to this case in accordance with Texas Government Code Sec. 411.081. Otherwise it will remain a public record.

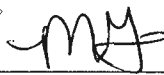

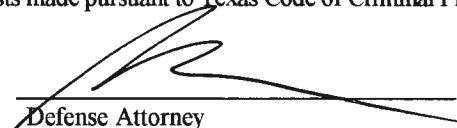

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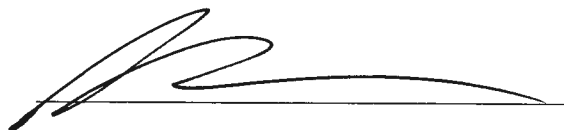

**ADVICE OF DEFENDANT'S RIGHT OF APPEAL**

The Court, pursuant to TEX. R. APP. P. 25.2, advises the Defendant as follows:

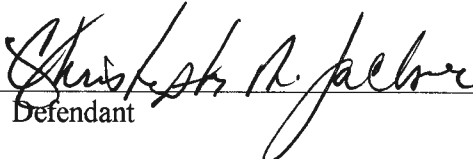
1. Texas law gives a defendant convicted of a crime the right to appeal his conviction.
2. If you **pled guilty** or **no contest** and accepted the punishment recommended by the prosecutor, you cannot appeal your conviction unless this Court gives you permission. If you **waived** or **gave up** your right to appeal, you **cannot** appeal your conviction.
3. If you did not plead guilty, you may have the right to appeal. If you **want** to appeal, you must give notice of appeal **in writing** to this Court's clerk within **30 days**.
4. If an attorney represents you in the court of appeals, your attorney must mail a copy of the court of appeals judgment and opinion to your last known address. You must tell your attorney, in writing, of any **change in your address**.
5. If you are not satisfied with your appeal's result, you can ask the Court of Criminal Appeals to review your case by filing a petition for discretionary review within **30 days** of the opinion's issuance in the court of appeals. If you fail to inform your attorney of any change in your address, you may lose the opportunity to seek discretionary review.

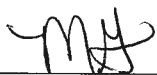

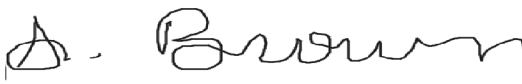

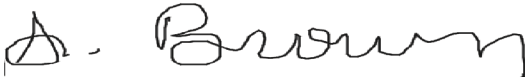

3. Defendant Christopher Malcom Jackson is a Texas resident that may be served at 1719 Blodgett St., Houston, Harris County, Texas 77004 or wherever he may be found.

**FACTS**

4. Plaintiff operates a pre-owned jewelry and luxury goods retail store located at 5707 Richmond Ave., Houston, TX 77057. On the afternoon of July 18, 2024, Defendant Christopher

Malcolm Jackson entered Plaintiff's store and negotiated for the sale of a Rolex Daytona Chronograph (the "Watch") for \$40,000.00

5. As part of the sale, Defendant signed the following buy contract and receipt:

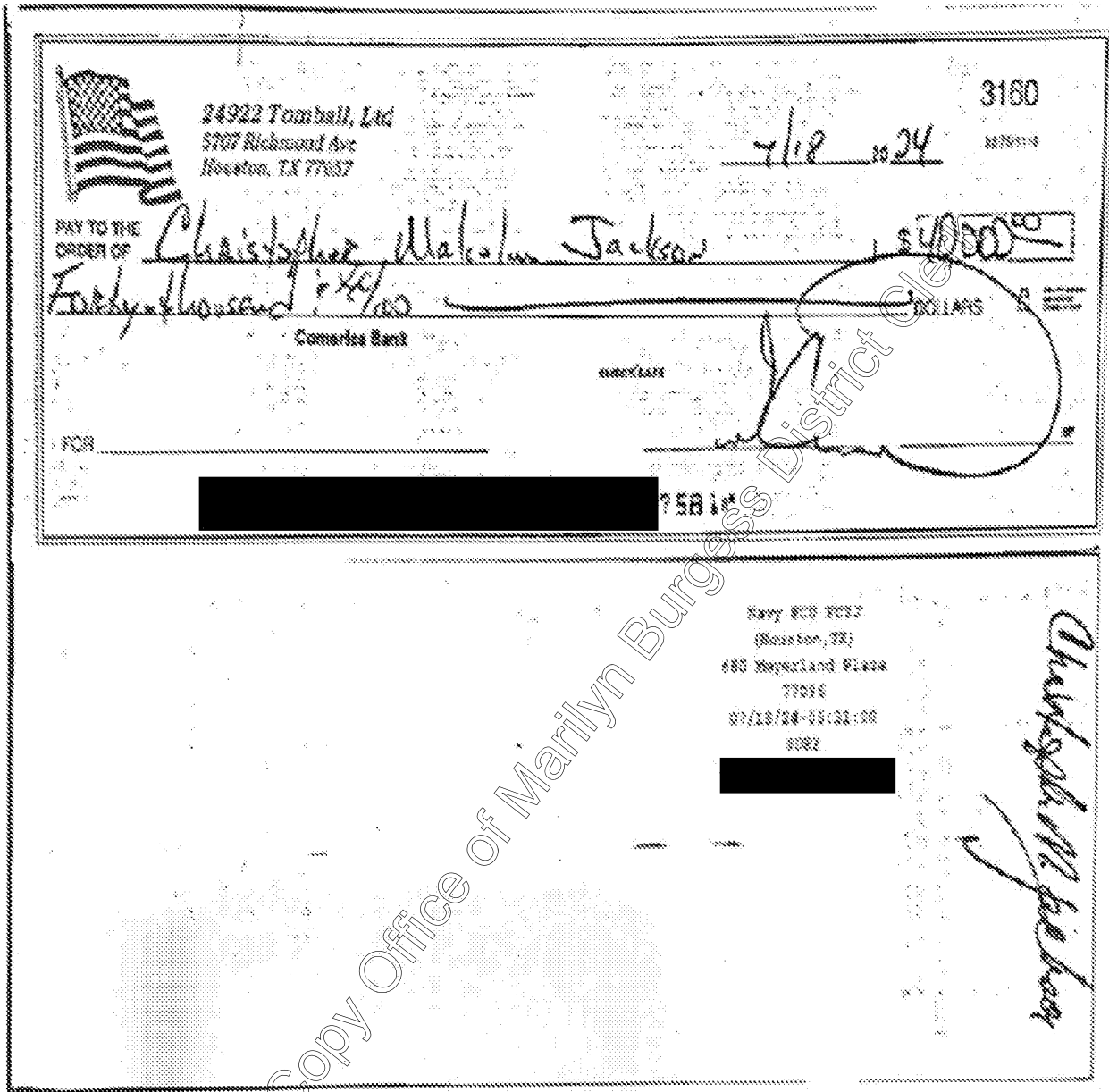

6. As set forth above, Defendant provided an affirmative statement and warranty that "transfer of [the Watch] is lawful, that [Defendant] has absolute ownership, and the [Defendant] ha[d] the right to possess and sell [the Watch]."

7. In exchange for the Watch and the above representation, Plaintiff wrote the following check to Defendant, which was later deposited in Defendant's bank account at Navy Federal Credit Union as indicated by Defendant's signature and the typewritten bank endorsement:



8. As it turns out, the Watch was reported stolen and Plaintiff is now being required to turnover the Watch to law enforcement.
9. Plaintiff is out \$40,000.00 and seeks its return through this lawsuit.

### BREACH OF CONTRACT

10. Plaintiff and Defendant had a contract for the purchase of the Watch. The contract required that Plaintiff receive the Watch from Defendant with good and lawful title and ownership.

Defendant could not and did not deliver a watch with a good title and thus Defendant breached the contract. Defendant's breach caused Plaintiff damage because police are taking the Watch. Plaintiff has been damaged by \$40,000.00, the amount paid to Defendant. Plaintiff seeks these damages.

### **FRAUD**

11. Defendant represented that "transfer of [the Watch to Plaintiff] is lawful, that [Defendant] has absolute ownership, and the [Defendant] ha[d] the right to possess and sell [the Watch]." On July 18, 2024, when the statement was made, Defendant knew it was false or lacked knowledge of its truth. Defendant intended that Plaintiff rely or act on the misrepresentation. Plaintiff relied upon the misrepresentation and thus delivered a check to Defendant for \$40,000.00. Plaintiff's reliance on the false statements caused injury as set forth herein.

15.
